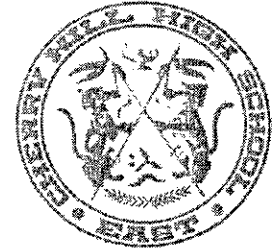

Dear East Families,

I hope that this letter finds you well. I am writing to provide clarity regarding the daily schedule for PARCC testing next week.

Starting next Monday, April 16th, High School East will be administering the Partnership for Assessment of Readiness for College and Careers (PARCC) assessment for English (ELA 9, 10 & 11) and Mathematics (Alg I & II and Geometry). Please note on the following schedule that all students arrive to school for a 7:30am start on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday; however, on Thursday, only students who are testing arrive for a 7:30am start, while non-testing students arrive to school for a 9:30am start time.

Additional information to note:


- Students who *refuse* to test will be assigned to study hall locations for the day.
- Seniors will have activities and presentations planned Mon-Wed.
- Students who are enrolled in a non-tested mathematics course will be assigned to a study hall after lunch.

Important Graduation Requirement Information:

- Class of 2019 (Juniors): Can meet graduation assessment requirement with a passing score in English AND Mathematics on one of the following assessments: PARCC, SAT, ACT, Accuplacer, or Portfolio Appeal Process.
- Class of 2020 (Sophomores): Can meet graduation assessment requirement with a passing score in English AND Mathematics on the PARCC assessment.
 - A passing score on the SAT, ACT, Accuplacer, or Portfolio Appeal Process will be accepted **ONLY IF** the student has **taken ALL PARCC assessments for which he/she is eligible.**
- Class of 2021 (Freshmen): Can meet the graduation assessment requirement through a passing score on the English 10 and Algebra 1 PARCC assessments.
 - Portfolio Appeal Process **ONLY IF** the student has **taken ALL PARCC ASSESSMENTS he/she is eligible for.**
